ST. ANDREW'S MINISTRIES

Outreach
 Help the community beyond St. Andrew's by serving meals at Kansas City Community Kitchen, assisting women and children at the Rose Brooks Center, organizing donations for St. Paul's Food Pantry, or supporting students at our partner schools, locally and in Haiti.

Hospitality
 Foster a sense of community at church by serving at events like coffee hour, Mardi Gras, and St. Andrew's Sunday. Help is needed with event promotion, food preparation, and space set-up/clean-up.

Parish Care
 Serve others by offering healing prayer with the Order of St. Luke, preparing or delivering meals, or "bringing Church" to the home-bound as a Eucharistic Visitor.

Worship
 Contribute to weekly services by preparing worship materials, sharing musical talents, reading scriptures, ushering, serving on Altar Guild, etc.

Children's Formation
 Engage the children of St. Andrew's by decorating a Children's Chapel bulletin board, organizing Sunday School supplies, volunteering at Vacation Bible School, or helping with special family events.

Youth Formation
 Serve St. Andrew's youth by sharing your time and skills with our Acolytes, Youth Group, or Boy Scout troop.

Adult Formation
 Enable fellow parishioners to deepen their faith by helping organize classes, guest speakers, or special topic forums.

Community Connections
 Make the church welcoming to guests and members by delivering mugs to newcomers, greeting worshipers as they arrive each week, or promoting special community events.
